

English

This term students will be examining and analysing information reports. Our focus this term will be on Australian animals, and through our investigations, students will also have multiple opportunities to write their own information reports using technology. Each student will work towards achieving their own individual writing goal, with teacher and/or SSO support, as well as through some conference groups.

Students will continue to participate in interactive reading each morning and will be given multiple opportunities to engage in meaningful discussion with their peers and use their comprehension skills to write about the book.

C19 will work towards reading decodable readers through RWI and daily rotations. They will develop their reading through individualised reading goals on comprehension, accuracy, fluency or vocabulary.

Maths: Measurement & Geometry

In maths, our focus will be on using units of measurements this term. At the beginning of the term we will be learning about time, including days of the week, months of the year, analog and digital time. We will then transition into measuring and comparing length, area, volume and capacity, using both informal and formal units.

Students will be working in small differentiated groups within rotations that will provide consolidating work as well as small group work with the teacher to learn new concepts.


All students in C19 will be working towards achieving their individualised maths goals throughout the term.

HASS: Geography

This term we will examine 'place', in particular Australia on a map. We will learn about the different states, and how people

Science this term will be focused around biological sciences. As a class we will be learning about living and non living things, external





are connected to places. Students will explore these themes through interactive online learning and through hands-on play.


features, needs and wants and life cycles. To tie in with our theme of Australian animals, our science lesson will have a focus on these animal groups. Students will explore this learning through hands-on experiments and observing and recording data.

PE: Mr Kyle
This term PE has an underlying focus on sports day events and allowing time for students to practice them. As our school sports day has been changed to term 3 instead of term 4, students will participate in multiple events throughout the first half of term 3. They will work collaboratively in groups to overcome any challenge and explore how their body works when put in various movement scenarios.

Health: Mr Kyle
This term students will be exploring diversity in our classroom. They will begin examining their own family heritage and comparing it with others in their class. Students will be asked to research and prepare a short presentation on their own cultural heritage. They will explore various games, food recipes and cultural norms which they will share with their peers. We will also be exploring respect and empathy as a whole and why they are so important when discussing diversity in our community.


The Arts: Mrs Rose (Visual)
This term in Visual Arts, we will be making a range of artworks that explore the art elements of line, colour, shape, texture, and form. We will explore how to use these elements together in artworks and how we can discuss how others have used them. We will be using a range of mediums like drawing, painting, collage, printmaking and sculpture. We will be using famous artists like Jimmy Pike, Kandinsky and Paul Klee to give us inspiration.

AUSLAN
This term students will be learning **Australian animal vocabulary** using Auslan. Students in C19 will implement Auslan signing during their morning and afternoon circle routines, moving towards independence.





<p>Digital Technologies: Ms Vivian</p> <p>This term students will learn about being safe when online. Students will be introduced to algorithms in a series of lessons which will see students design a sequence of steps for others to follow. Students will also tinker with the floor robots and Bee Bots and learn early coding and programming skills.</p>	<p>Kitchen Garden: Ms Michele</p> <p>This term in the kitchen we will be cooking Indian, Asian and Italian inspired dishes. We will be using produce from our garden to create some of these dishes. Students will be spending more time in the garden getting it ready for the spring and summer growing seasons. This will include weeding, mulching and planting seeds. The middle and upper year levels will be helping put together the new chicken house and run.</p>
<p>Wellbeing</p> <p>Students will continue to access their zone charts and work 1:1 with the teacher to identify new strategies that will assist them in becoming ready to learn and to help regulate their emotions. They will continue to work towards recognising their own emotions and the emotions of others. Social stories and social skills/games will be frequently used to consolidate this learning.</p> <p>Year 5 and 6 students will be participating in sexual health and relationships on Wednesdays with D1 & D2.</p>	<p>Swimming</p> <p>This term swimming is being held at the Parks Recreation and Sport Center in Angle Park. We will be traveling to and from school via private bus every Friday.</p> <p>As there has been a slight time change compared to last term, can students please come to school on Friday's with their bathers underneath their school clothes.</p> <p>All students need to have bathers, a towel and a plastic bag.</p>
