

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## C8 NEWS

We have been very busy developing our building skills! For our Father's Day gifts we had a special visitor, Vince from Bunnings Parafield. ## C19 NEWS

This term we have been looking at Chemical Sciences. We have been learning about evaporation, melting and freezing. We explored this by timing how long different household items (sauce, water, salt water and salad dressing) would freeze, melt and evaporate. We were surprised to find out that salt water melted faster than plain water. We have studied different methods of producing clean water including filtering and we made a solar still to distill salt water. The solar still didn't work as planned as the sun wasn't hot enough to heat the water to boiling point. In our exploration of different mixtures, we made sherbet. We tasted different unknown ingredients, some tasted good and others were disgusting. We then made our own sherbet by mixing the ingredients in different ways until we found the perfect recipe.
